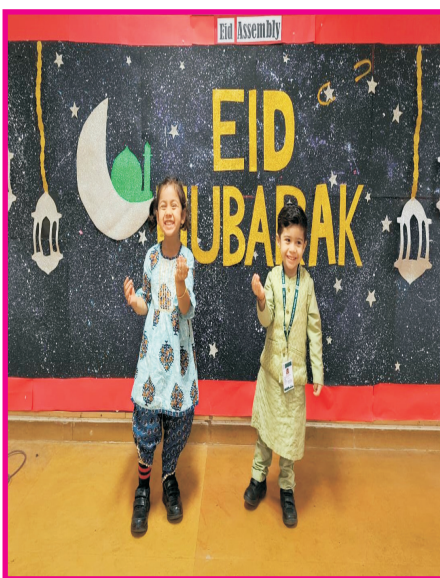


Eid Mubarak
