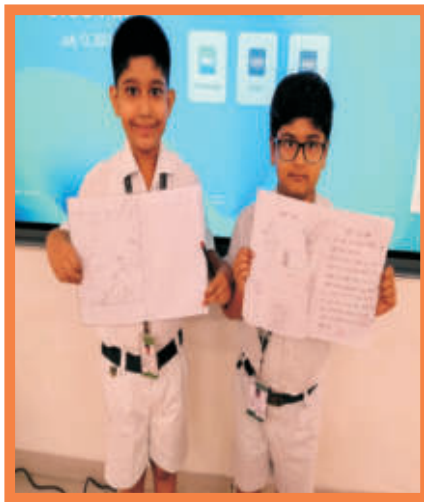

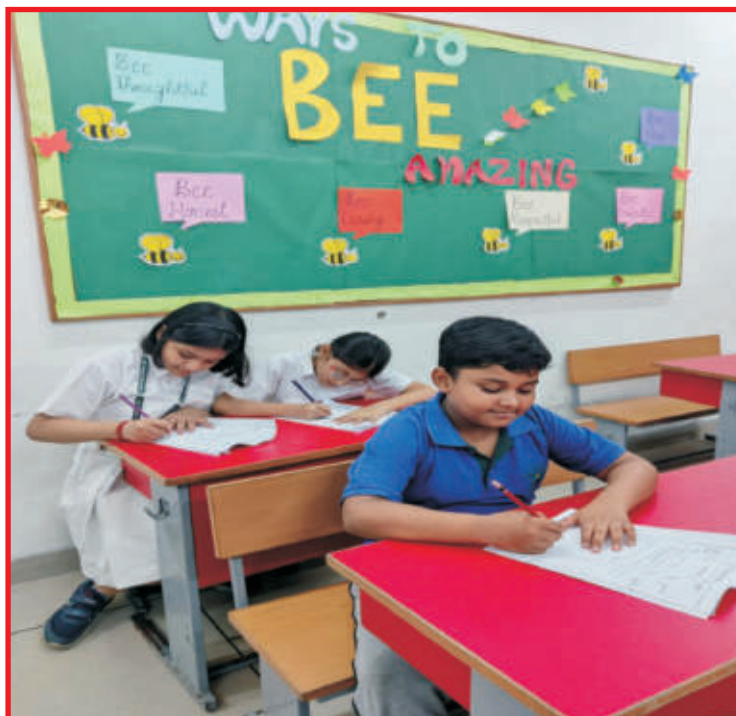
OPEN HOUSE

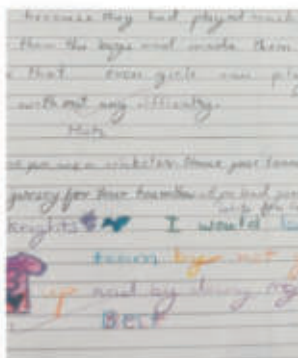
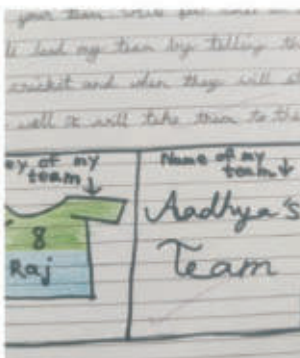


Subject Integrated

At DPS GBN, we create a supportive learning environment where students can foster a sense of curiosity about nature and world and it helps them develop appreciation for the environment.

The Students of Grade 3 learnt about different functions of beaks and claws, such as how some birds use their beaks to crack nuts, while the others use it to catch insects etc. The main objective of this activity was to make them identify the different shapes of beaks and claws of birds and help them understand how different beaks and claws shapes are adapted to different environments and food sources. This activity also helped students develop a deeper understanding about the natural world and help them develop an appreciation for the diversity of life on Earth. The importance of birds in an environment was also discussed in the class.

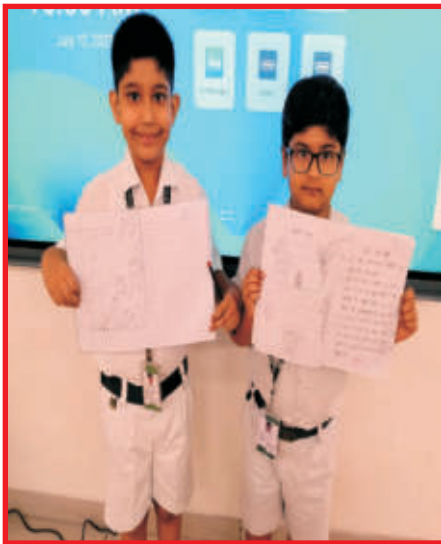


‘दीपावली त्योहार न होकर एक संस्कृति है, जो पूरे भारत को एकता के सूत्र में पिरोती है।’

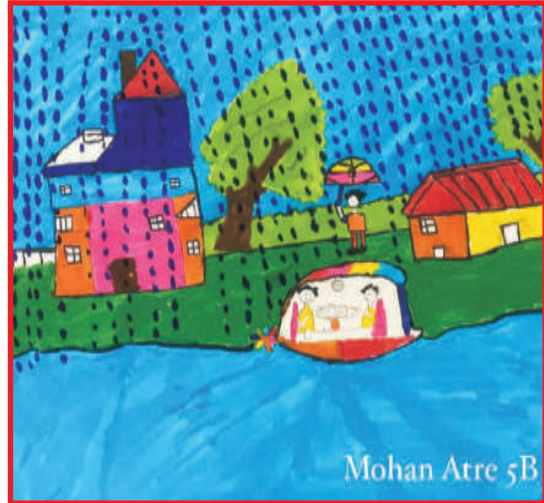
Performing Arts
