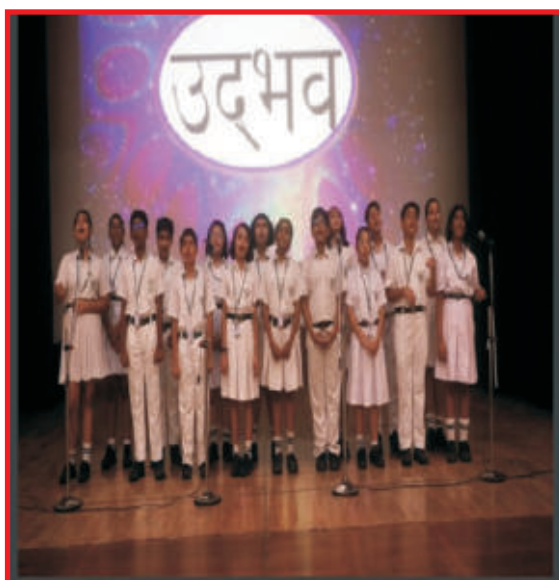


Udbhav- Inter School Hindi Fest
