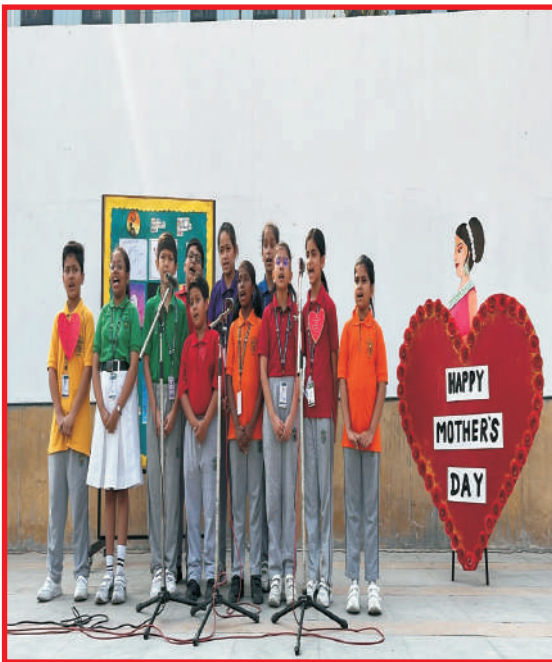
Tête-à-Tête

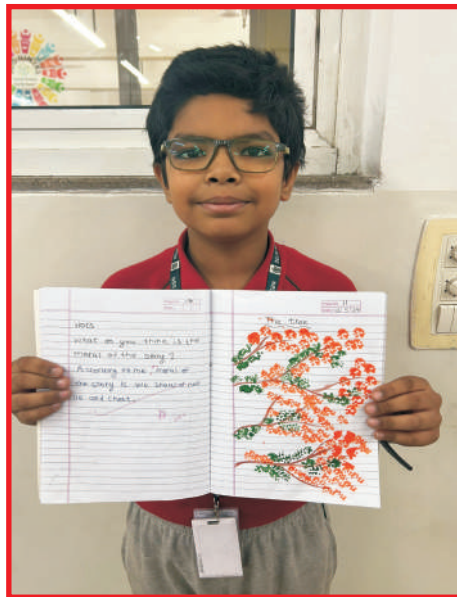
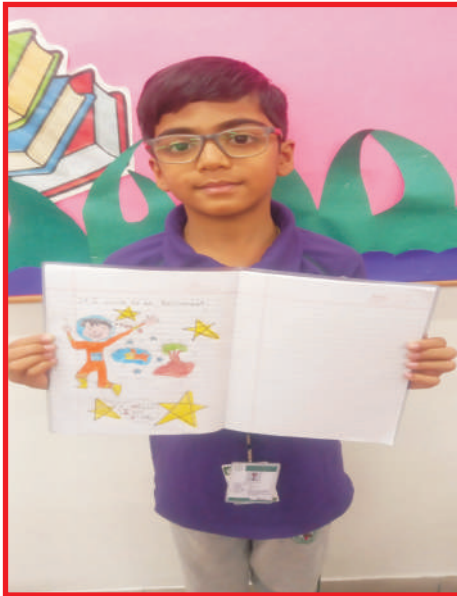

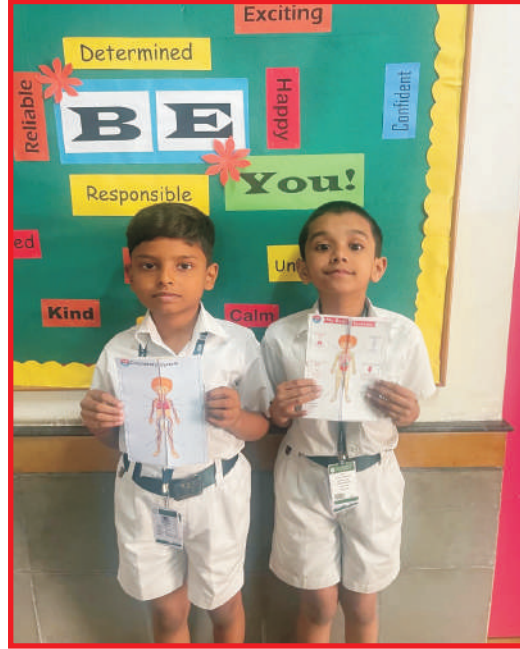
Bringing Literature to Life: Primary Students Engage in Poem Illustration Activity

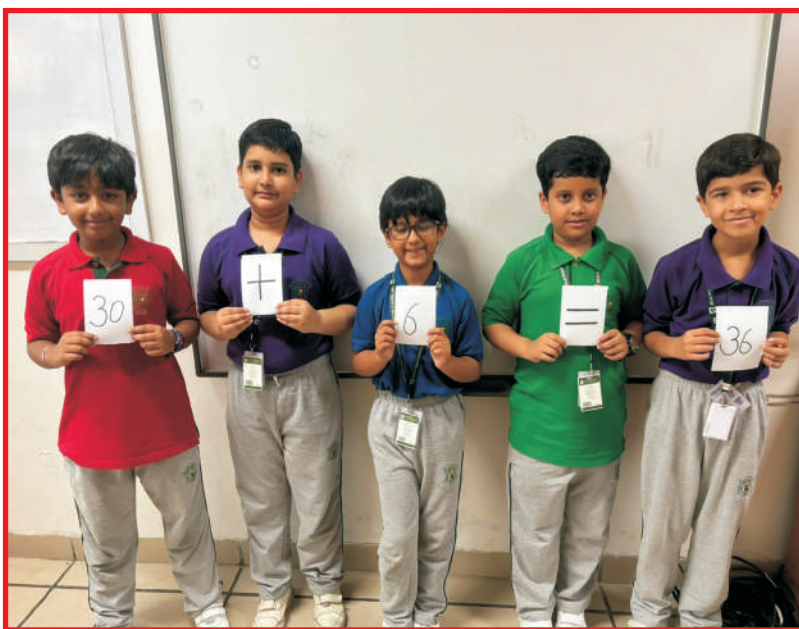


Mathematics

Computers

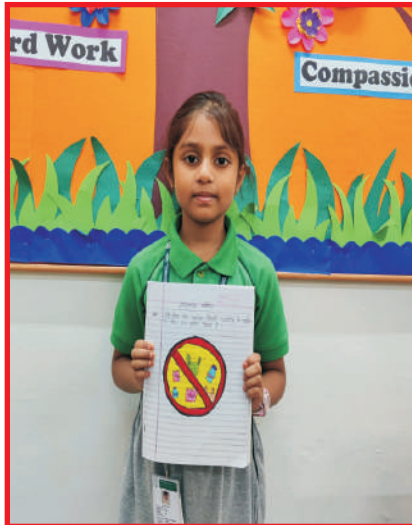

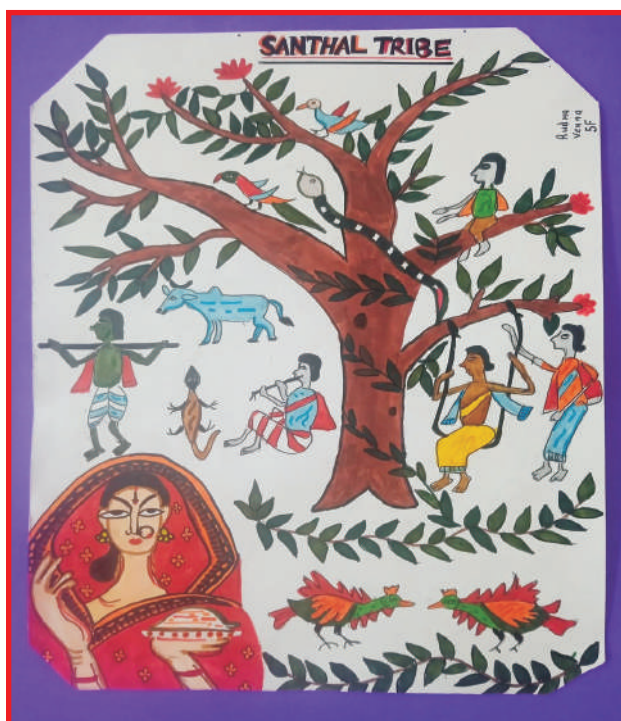
