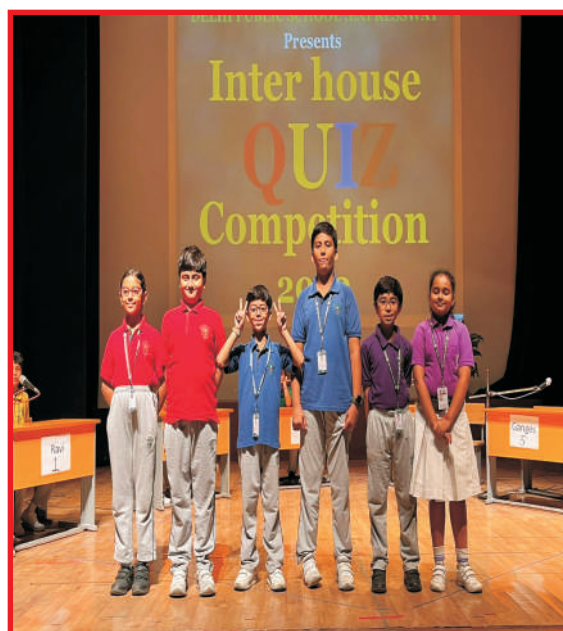

Inter House Quiz Competition

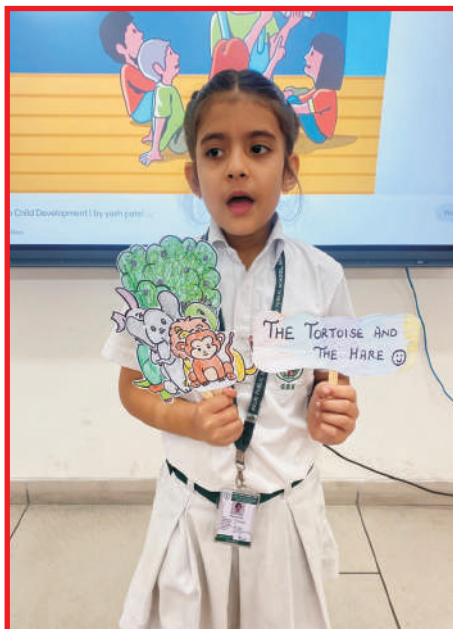
