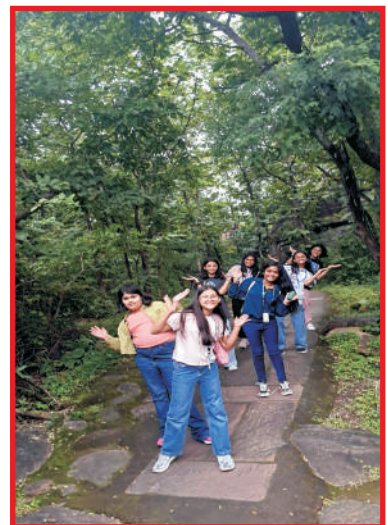
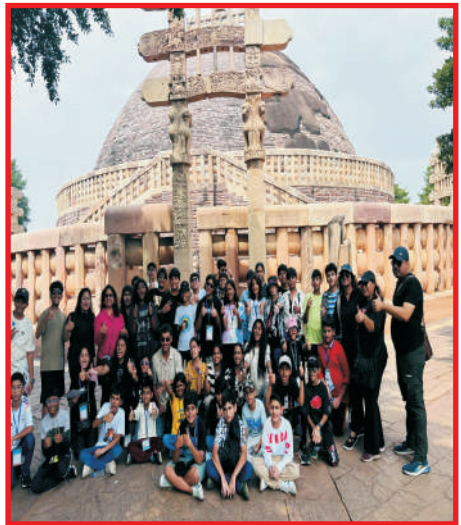
The Hindi Diwas celebration was a resounding success. The Students demonstrated their passion for Hindi and their commitment to preserving India's cultural heritage.



From Lakes to Legacy: An Educational Odyssey in Bhopal

As part of our School's annual educational trip initiative, Students of Grade 7 embarked on an excursion to Bhopal, the capital city of Madhya Pradesh from September 17-22, 2024. The excursion was aimed at providing Students with a hands-on learning experience, enriching their knowledge of history, culture, and architecture, while also developing camaraderie and a sense of responsibility.

The trip began with an overnight journey by train from Delhi, and upon arrival in Bhopal, the Students checked into their hotel. After breakfast and orientation, they headed to the historic Sanchi Stupa, a UNESCO World Heritage site, and explored the Archaeological Museum. The adventure continued with a journey to Bhimbetka, another UNESCO World Heritage site, renowned for its ancient rock shelters and prehistoric paintings. After an enriching visit, the group proceeded to Panchmarhi, a beautiful hill station. The students were enthusiastic and engaged throughout the trip. They particularly enjoyed visiting the historical monuments and learning outside the classroom. The excursion not only helped in enhancing their knowledge but also fostered a sense of responsibility, teamwork, and curiosity among the Students.



Curiosity Voyage: Trip to Ranthambore

An educational trip to Ranthambore National Park was organized for Grade 6 Students to enhance their learning about wildlife, ecosystems, and conservation efforts. The park, renowned for its population of Bengal tigers and rich biodiversity, provided the perfect setting for the Students to experience nature and wildlife firsthand.

The Students went on a three-day excursion i.e., from September 20-22, to Ranthambore, staying at Puratan Qila Resort. The trip included a trek to Ranthambore Fort, followed by a Rajasthani cultural show. The second day featured a Jungle Safari, a visit to the Ranthambore Museum, and a documentary on the tigress Machhli. Students also visited the Dastakhar NGO, where they participated in block painting. The day ended with a DJ night. On the final day, a closing ceremony was held, and Students left with fond memories of the trip.



Cultural Exchange: Unfolding the Mystique of Japan

On September 26, Students from Grades 6-8 had the opportunity to visit the Japan Foundation. This visit aimed to provide Students with a comprehensive understanding of Japanese culture, language, and the significance of Japan-India relations. The event was both educational and engaging, offering Students a unique perspective on Japan's rich heritage.

They learned about Japanese culture, learnt about Japan through Japan Quiz, Played Japanese Karuta game and explored Mangas by visiting their library. The Japanese Students were very happy and took part in all the activities with enthusiasm. The hands-on activities and engaging presentations left a lasting impression on the Students, sparking their interest in learning more about Japan. Feedback from Students was overwhelmingly positive. Many expressed a newfound interest in the Japanese language and culture, with several stating they would like to explore further educational opportunities related to Japan.
